#### Flexible, Quality, Relevant & Personalised

Through collective expertise and strategic links with educational partners, AeU is aiming to deliver programmes that focus on flexibility, quality, relevance and personalised learning.

AeU's cross-border and cross-culture programmes had attracted over 700 PhD and 1300 Master's students from Malaysia, Bahrain, India, Vietnam, Indonesia and other countries.

A wide range of choices are given to AeU's learners namely practical education in management, education and information technology.

#### Faculties/Schools

Assessment is flexible with a practical combination of 60 percent assignment and 40 percent examination - ensuring that its more practical rather than theory based. AeU also is one of the few universities allowed to practice Open Entry Systems.

SGS is a one-stop centre for graduate students and researchers worldwide and in Malaysia it helps students in independent research with the guidance of supervisor(s) and workshops as well as personalised support. PhDs in Business Administration, Education, ICT and Arts are available.

Other programmes offered are Industrial Doctorate (IndD), Master of Science Management by Research, Master of Social Science by Research and Master of Humanities & Arts by Research.
