degree has given me a better intellectual insight and is an achievement he did not expect at the age of 70," he said.

An exemplary alumun, Dr Tan Teik Kheong is the first Industrial Doctorate graduate in AeU and is conferred the title of 'Senior Corporate Fellow' for his outstanding achievements. He is an International Prestigious Award Winner among many foreign contestants at the London Hedge Fund Competition in 2014. He is the Chief Executive Officer of Oceana Ventures, Chairman of IEEE Next Generation Wireless and Vice Chairman if Wi-Fi Alliance 802.11n Marketing. He is an educator, founder of several start-ups mentor, and technopreneur in the digital economy.

## Fast Facts on AeU

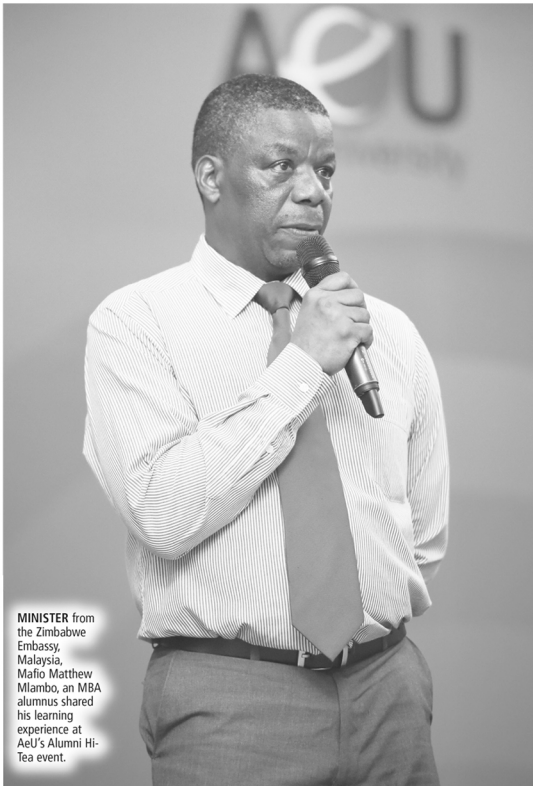
